Attn. Students: As you are aware we are going to a modified closed campus next year. Freshman and Sophomore students will be restricted to campus while Junior and Seniors in good standing will be allowed to leave campus during lunch. Good Standing means that students are not academically ineligible or citizenship ineligible. Current sophomores and junior's who are ineligible at the end of this school year, will not be allowed off campus for lunch during the entire first semester next year. In addition if you have failed to fulfill your Thursday/Saturday school requirements for the current school year, you will be deemed ineligible and will loose your lunch privileges for next year. Eligibility is reviewed at the semester only. I encourage current students to work on their academics and attendance and give your best effort over the next few weeks of school. The choices you make today will definitely impact you next year.

Attn. Students: Current 9<sup>th</sup> -11<sup>th</sup> grade students must submit current immunization records indicating that the Tdap vaccine has been received on or after the 10th birthday. By law, all students entering 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades will need proof of a whooping cough booster shot prior to the start of the 2011-12 school year. Students who have not submitted proper notification and proof of receiving the Tdap booster shot will <u>not</u> be able to start school until proof is received. We encourage all current 9th-11th grade HHS students to bring a copy of their immunization records to Mrs. Downing our school registrar, located in the main office, by May 27<sup>th</sup>. If you have not had the Tdap vaccine, information regarding the Kings County Health Department vaccination clinic schedule was mailed to all HHS families in the HHS April Newsletter. Teachers have also been sent this information. Students and their families can also make an appointment with their primary doctor. Some local drug stores in the area have also posted on their doors the Tdap vaccine is available there.
